About Diabetes

Diabetes is a chronic disease found in 2 main groups: Type 1 diabetes (T1D) is an autoimmune reaction where the body's own immune system mistakenly attacks and destroys its own insulin-producing cells. T1D patients become immediate life dependent on insulin injections. Type 2 diabetes (T2D) where the body's ability to utilize the insulin it produces is reduced. Many T2D patients are now also dependent on insulin injections.

Living with diabetes requires attention around the clock in a constant and difficult balancing food intake, activity, and insulin injections to keep blood glucose levels within normal limits. The fact that it, with current therapies is an impossible challenge to complete, is evidence by the daily cost of 86 million. DKK to treat diabetes.
